You are invited to take part in a research study being conducted by Dr. XXXX in conjunction with the Centre for Experimental Social Sciences. In concordance with CESS policy, today's study has received approval of its ethicality from CESS's independent review board.

We ask that you read this form carefully prior to deciding whether to participate in the study. If you decide you do not want to participate, you may leave at any time without providing a reason and without penalty. If you choose to leave prior to the completion of the study, your data will not be stored for later use.

Purpose: The purpose of this study is to better understand what individuals believe and how they make decisions regarding their health.

What Happens During the Study: The study requires you to sit in front of a computer terminal and make a series of decisions that may affect your final earnings and the final earnings of others. After the main part of your experiment, you will be asked to answer some survey questions about your personal characteristics and opinions. Some parts of the study may ask you about topics that make you feel uncomfortable such as your mental health or your views on family planning. You may feel uncomfortable with some of the questions asked but you do not need to answer questions that you do not want to answer.

Participation: The study is expected to take up to XXXX minutes and you will be paid you earnings through PayPal within two weeks of the studies conclusion. Please note that an active Paypal account is necessary to receive compensation for taking part in the study. If you do not receive your compensation within two weeks of the completion of the study, please contact <u>cess-online@nuffield.ox.ac.uk</u>. You always have the option of stopping your participation in the study and you may leave at any time without providing a reason and without penalty. If you leave prior to the completion of the study, your data will not be stored and you will not receive compensation for your participation.

Potential Risks: Participation in today's study poses minimal risk. None of the risks are greater than those encountered in daily life. Your responses are strictly confidential and will only be accessible to the researchers. Below, we describe the steps we are taking to protect your privacy. In addition, your decision on whether to participate will not adversely affect your relationship with CESS, the University of Oxford, or the organizations to which the researchers are affiliated.

Benefits: Beyond the compensation you will receive for your participation today, you are aiding the further development of science. Additionally, the information you receive during the study may help you make better decisions in the future.

Compensation: You will receive a minimum of £X for completing the study. You can earn considerable more during the course of the study. Your final earnings may be determined by your decisions, the decisions of others and luck. Although we cannot tell you exactly how

Data Protection and Privacy:

The information collected during the study will be kept private. In concordance with the Data Protection Act of 1998 & 2018, the University of Oxford is the data controller. Responsible members of the University of Oxford and funders may be given access to data for monitoring and/or audit of the study to ensure we are complying with the guidelines or as otherwise required by law.

The original data will be made anonymous and then stored on CESS's secure server that is only accessible by members of CESS. No one other than members of CESS and responsible members of the University of Oxford will have access to any records of this experiment, and none of the records will identify you using any personal information. The data will be stored in electronic form, password protected. A copy of the anonymized data will be provided to the primary investigator listed at the top of this form. The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored or processed at a destination outside the United Kingdom. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing, or processing. Your individual privacy will be maintained in all publications or presentations resulting from this study. No information about you provided by you during this research will be disclosed to others without your written permission, except:

- if necessary to protect your rights or welfare (for example, if you are injured and need emergency care); or

- if required by law.
